A fully equipped hairdressing salon is provided for use by the on-staff hairdresser. (Hairdressing service is at an additional cost). Some rooms overlooking the Angas River.

### **Services**

Permanent Care, Respite Care and Memory Support Care

The facility was established in 1988 with extensions built in 2003 to accommodate a further 24 places and 2021 to accommodate 12 bed memory support unit; with 2022 welcoming a further 24 beds to support our elder residents

During this time building refurbishment and development has included upgrades to kitchen servery areas, new lighting, replacement flooring and courtyard pergola improvements as part of our commitment to providing a quality home environment.

We offer different accommodation styles; rooms are a combination of single and shared. The rooms have pleasant décor, fixtures and fittings; plus large windows for natural light. The facility offers 68 places in total for permanent residential care and accommodation for respite care (bookings essential).

Its 24-bed dedicated secure area offers extra support for residents with behaviors and/or memory loss. In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer scheduled visits by a General Practitioner, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Dental, Optometrist, Mental Health Care and Podiatrist.

There are onsite weekly religious services supported by local ministers' fraternal group visits. Emotional and spiritual support to residents and families is readily available. Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily and there is a rotating menu.

We are located close to the towns shopping, recreational facilities and the renowned High Street, home to many antique shops. Co-located with the Hospital there is ready access to medical care. It has strong links with the local community, churches, and business. The staff, volunteers and residents participate in community events such as the Strathalbyn Show and Christmas Pageant. Many of the staff live locally and provide 24-hour support from a dedicated team of staff offering ageing in place. They take pride in providing compassionate and professional care.

## Location/Access

Located on High Street in the township of Strathalbyn it fronts both High Street and Alfred Place and is accessible from both. Strathalbyn also boasts fine restaurants and eateries. The facility benefits from wellmaintained roads and good footpaths. The heritage town of Strathalbyn is located 58 kilometers south of Adelaide on the banks of the Angas River. It retains many of its historic buildings dating back to its early Scottish settlements and is surrounded by a mixture of various faming enterprises, vineyards, olive tree groves and tourist attractions. Just a short distance to the beautiful Fleurieu Peninsular and the equally picturesque Adelaide hills. The facility is easily accessible to local amenities via taxi service.

The facility itself is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility offering a home-like atmosphere in open plan accommodation for singles and couples. The facility supports disabled access and parking is available at the front and rear of the facility. The facility is fully secure.

## Leisure & Well-Being

Barossa Hills Fleurieu Local Health Network caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues. Residents are encouraged to maintain community links and are assisted to attend offsite meetings. Visiting pet therapy: The facility utilises visiting "canine companions" and encourages well behaved pets to visit with families.



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
