The Coober Pedy Hospital & Health Services provides Permanent Care, Respite Care, Ageing in Place

The Coober Pedy Hospital & Health Services is a Multi-Purpose Site (MPS) established in 2008 with 4 high level residential beds. Prior to this time the facility supported high care for Aboriginal and the wider community. The facility was then State and Commonwealth funded.

In 2002 Umoona Aged Care Aboriginal Corporation was established as a shared care arrangement with Coober Pedy Hospital & Health Services until their own establishment was extended to include high level care in November 2009. Aged care services support the township of Coober Pedy, Marla, Mintabie, Oodnadatta and surrounding environs.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer Recovery Pathways to maintenance of independence and achieving personal goals, Allied Health (high care only), Medicare, On-site access to GP, pharmacy, incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service) – (high care only), entertainment, electrical appliance testing, postal service, gardening assistance, arrangements for room telephone connections.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily, complimented by a rotating menu.

Location/Access

Cooper Pedy Health Service is situated in the small township of Coober Pedy located in the remote northern area of South Australia.

Leisure & Well-Being

Cooper Pedy Health Service caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

A central courtyard area provides a peaceful place to take time out to relax and enjoy the surroundings.

Additional services can be arranged i.e. hairdresser, connections to telephone services at additional cost to the resident.
