#### **Communal Areas**

Hawker Memorial Hospital has a Lounge/Dining Room, sitting areas, hairdressing room, community room courtyard/garden and a balcony/verandah.

#### **Services**

The Hawker Memorial Hospital was founded in 1923. It currently has 12 beds, with 8 of those dedicated to High Care Residential Care as part of the Flinders Ranges Multipurpose Service. This includes Quorn, Hawker and Leigh Creek. Hawker Hospital is accredited through the Australian Council on Healthcare Standards till August 2024.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer Healthy Ageing programs, Recovery pathways to maintenance of independence and achieving personal goals, Allied Health (high care only), Social Worker, Diversional Therapist, Chaplain, Medicare, on-site access to GP, incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service) – (high care only), entertainment, electrical appliance testing, postal service.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily, complimented by a rotating menu.

#### Location/Access

Hawker Memorial Hospital is situated in the Flinders Ranges area of South Australia in the small rural township of Hawker. Hawker Memorial Hospital is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility, offering a home-like atmosphere for singles and couples.

#### Leisure & Well-Being

Hawker Memorial Hospital caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Lifestyle Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

Large verandas surround the hospital with rooms that open up to the outside. An ideal place to sit and view the Flinders Ranges is the Sensory Garden, a space with shelter from the sun and bird attracting plants. A friendly, but informal, living environment is what the staff strive to achieve.
