The Community Home has a lounge, dining, piano and sitting area. There is also a meeting room, courtyard, front garden, gazebo, and verandah areas.

Services

Orroroo Community Home provides Permanent Care, Respite Care and Ageing in Place.

Orroroo Community Home initially commenced in the original stone building in Fourth Street in 1965, providing very low care accommodation to 21 elderly community members, progressing to "ageing in place". In order to meet the standards of aged care provision, the physical location also changed to the new 16 bed facility in Fifth Street in 2001 and 5 Bed licences being transferred to the hospital in 2010 and closure of the Original Building.

Today we have 16 Commonwealth Aged Care beds providing high care.

In addition to the comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer recovery pathways to maintenance of independence and achieving personal goals, Allied health, Social Worker, Diversional Therapist, Medicare, on-site access to GP, pharmacy, incontinence products & toiletries, entertainment, electrical appliance testing, postal service, gardening assistance, arrangements for room telephone connections and assistance with transport.

The Orroroo Community Home is proud of the exceptional quality of food offered to meet all requirements of consumers' nutrition and hydration. All meals are prepared on site daily, using fresh ingredients and complemented by a rotating menu with individual consumer choice.

Location/Access

Situated in the Mid North of South Australia, Orroroo is a quiet country township located in an agricultural region. The Orroroo Community Home is a single level facility, offering a home-like atmosphere for singles and couples with gardens and outdoor areas.

Leisure & Well-Being

Orroroo Community Home partners with consumers from diverse cultural backgrounds and the Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of consumers with dementia and other health issues.

Our staff, volunteers, residents, family, and others participate in community events including Christmas Pageant, ANZAC services, and other significant events. Regular trips to surrounding districts are provided by care workers and annual trips to see the Christmas light display in the town. In addition to the regular community events and friendships, the individual consumers' lifestyle choices are encouraged and supported.

The Orroroo Community Home has built strong partnerships which encourage ongoing community engagement and positive outcomes for consumers during their stay.

Additional services can be arranged i.e., newspapers, hairdresser, telephone, Austar, and outings at an additional cost to the consumer.
