Orroroo Hospital Aged Care provides Permanent Care, Respite Care and Ageing in Place.

Orroroo Hospital Aged Care initially commenced with 5 State Aged Care Beds which were approved and transitioned to Commonwealth Residential Aged Care beds in 2012, following the transfer of 5 Residential Aged Care beds from the Original Building in Fourth Street in 2010 bringing it to 10 beds as it is today.

In addition to the comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer recovery pathways to maintenance of independence by achieving personal goals, Allied health, Social Worker, Diversional Therapist, Medicare, on-site access to GP, pharmacy, incontinence products & toiletries, entertainment, electrical appliance testing, postal service, gardening assistance, arrangements for room telephone connections and assistance with transport.

Orroroo Hospital Aged Care is proud of the exceptional quality of food offered to meet all requirements of consumers' nutrition and hydration. All meals are prepared on site daily, using fresh ingredients and complemented by a rotating menu with individual consumer choice.

Location/Access

Situated in the Mid North of South Australia, Orroroo is a quiet country township located in an agricultural region. Orroroo Hospital Aged Care is a single level facility located within the hospital, offering a home-like atmosphere for singles and couples and features spectacular views from the veranda and most rooms.

Leisure & Well-Being

Orroroo Hospital Aged Care partners with consumers from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of consumers with dementia and other health issues.

Our staff, volunteers, residents, and others participate in community events including Christmas Pageant, ANZAC services and other significant events. Regular trips to surrounding districts are provided by care workers and annual trips to see the Christmas light display in the town. In addition to the regular community events and friendships, the individual consumers' lifestyle choices are encouraged and supported.
