Room Type	Single Room with Private Ensuite
Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)	\$390,000 (Price Category 3). A RAD retention of 2% per annum is calculated daily and deducted monthly from the RAD balance and is limited to 5 years.
Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)	\$81.74 per day. The DAP will be indexed on 20 March and 20 September each year in line with changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
Explanation of payment options	Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) or a combination of both. A RAD is paid as a lump sum amount. A DAP accrues daily and is paid fortnightly. A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum and daily payments. Both payment methods are subject to retentions and indexation as noted above.
Example of combination payment	An example based on 50% RAD and 50% DAP would be: \$195,000 RAD plus an ongoing DAP of \$40.87 per day (indexed as above).
Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR)	The current maximum permissible interest rate is 7.65% as of 1 January 2026

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Communal Areas

Jamestown Health Service has a day room, residents lounge, private lounge, gardens, gazebo, verandah areas and courtyard.

Services

Jamestown Health Service provides Permanent Care, Respite Care and Ageing in Place.

Symonds Wing is located at the Yorke and Northern Local Health Network (YNLHN) Jamestown Hospital and Health Service.

Symonds Wing currently has predominately private rooms, with one share room available. The home has strong and historical links with the community and the building was part funded from a generous bequest and through the active support of the local Jamestown Hospital Auxiliary and the Mid North Health Advisory Committee.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer alternate therapies (massage), Allied health, Leisure/Diversional Therapy coordinator, Chaplain (visiting), Medicare, On-site access to GP, pharmacy (off site), Incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service), entertainment, postal service, laundry service, Transport Vehicle, Community Bus access (non-disabled access), gardening assistance, arrangements for room telephone connections, television, newspaper and hairdressing services.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily, complimented by a rotating menu developed by dietitians.

Location/Access

Situated in the Mid North of South Australia, Jamestown is a quiet country township located in an agricultural region. Jamestown Health Service is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility, offering a home-like atmosphere for both singles and couples. Landscaped gardens and surrounds are a feature of the facility. Symonds Wing is bounded by a courtyard and a sensory garden which is located adjacent to the Jamestown Health Service.

Leisure & Well-Being

Jamestown Health Service caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

We also have an active team of enthusiastic volunteers who support the residents in the home, and this includes lifestyle and leisure activities. A team of local pastoral chaplains also provide spiritual support and church services on a fortnightly basis.

Additional services can be arranged i.e., Community Bus Trips, specific magazines and newspapers purchase, hairdresser, at additional cost to the resident.
