KIHS was established many years ago and has developed into a high standards facility, with impressive surrounds.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer scheduled visits by a General Practitioner, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Optometrist and Podiatrist.

There are onsite religious services in the chapel and a practitioner visits regularly to provide emotional and spiritual support to residents and families.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily and there is a rotating menu.

We are co-located with the hospital there is ready access to comprehensive medical care. All beds are equipped with a staff call paging system.

Our dedicated team of staff provides 24 hour support with most of them living in the local area and have been with us for many years, ensuring continuity of care. They take pride in providing compassionate and professional care. Small remote communities recognise the importance of having health care facilities that support their needs and in turn are extremely supportive of the Kangaroo Island Health Service on a regular and sustainable level.

Location/Access

We are located 110km south-west of Adelaide and easily accessible by ferry or plane. Kangaroo Island is Australia's third largest island. The health service is situated within the township of Kingscote on the Esplanade with wonderful sea views, close to the shopping precinct and recreational facilities. The town features commerce, well maintained roads and footpaths. It is the largest town on Kangaroo Island having a population of approx. 2,000 plus it's a well-established tourist destination and home to a colony of the smallest penguins in the world.

We are a single level Residential Aged Care Facility, offering a home-like atmosphere in open plan accommodation and features landscaped gardens and surrounds. The site is easily accessible to local amenities and the facility offers ample parking both at the front and rear; and supports disabled access. The facility is fully secure.
