Communal Areas

Eudunda Seniors Citizens Hostel and Aged Care offers 31 beds across two buildings. The facilities have access to communal lounge/dining/activities, hairdressing salon, communal courtyard and gardens. The communal areas are in above average condition.

Services

Permanent Care, Respite Care, Dementia Specific Care, Ageing in Place

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer scheduled visits by a General Practitioner, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Dietician, Speech Therapy and Podiatrist.

There are onsite religious services to provide emotional and spiritual support to residents and families.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily and there is a rotating menu.

Co-located with the Hospital there is ready access to medical care. Eudunda Aged Care is an important part of the local community, with most of the residents coming from the surrounding district. Our staff, volunteers and residents participate in community events such as the Christmas Pageant, Carols and ANZAC day.

A dedicated team of staff provide 24 hour support. Most of our staff live in the local area and have been with us for many years, ensuring continuity of care. Staff takes pride in providing compassionate and professional care.

Location/Access

Eudunda is a rural town in South Australia, roughly 103 kilometres northeast of Adelaide, established in 1870 after settlers began moving into the area in the 1860s. Eudunda was the birthplace of world- renowned author Colin Thiele, whose bronzed sculpture (by Chris Radford) is in the Centenary Gardens. The gardens also contain stone walls and tiled art.

It is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility with excellent accessibility on a flat site, offering a home-like atmosphere in open plan accommodation for singles and couples and features landscaped gardens and surrounds.

The facility is fully secure.

Leisure & Well-Being

Barossa Hills Fleurieu Local Health Network caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

Residents are encouraged to maintain community links and are assisted to attend offsite meetings.
