## **Communal Areas**

At Kapunda Homes we offer the choice of two (2) lounge areas and a communal dining room. There is an onsite hairdressing salon. Picturesque gardens are well maintained and feature a courtyard with ample seating and bbg facilities.

The communal areas are in above average condition.

#### **Services**

Permanent Care, Respite Care, Dementia Specific Care, Ageing in Place

Kapunda Homes comprises single ensuite rooms with communal dining and lounge rooms.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer scheduled visits by a General Practitioner, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Dietician, Speech therapist and Podiatrist.

There are onsite religious services in the chapel and a practitioner visits regularly to provide emotional and spiritual support to residents and families.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily and a rotating menu is on offer.

We are an important part of the local community, with most of the residents coming from the surrounding district. Our staff, volunteers and residents participate in community events.

Our dedicated team of staff provides 24 hour support with most of the staff living in the local area and have been with us for many years, ensuring continuity of care. They take pride in providing compassionate and professional care.

The facility is fully secure.

#### Location/Access

We are co-located with the Hospital, ensuring ready access to medical care. Located close to the towns shopping and recreational facilities they are easily accessed by well-maintained roads and reasonable footpaths

Kapunda itself is a quiet country township located 87 kilometres from Adelaide on the Light River and near the Barossa Valley. The town has been dominated since 1988 by the 8 metre tall statue of Map Kernow ("the son of Cornwall"), a traditional Cornish miner.

Kapunda is a producer of cereal crops, mainly wheat, barley and oats. Value added services carried out by local industry include stock feed milling and hay processing. Kapunda is a contributor to the wine-growing industry centered in the nearby Barossa Valley.

Our facility is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility, offering a home-like atmosphere in open plan accommodation for singles and couples and features landscaped gardens and surrounds. The facility is fully secure.

#### Leisure & Well-Being

Barossa Hills Fleurieu Local Health Network caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

Residents are encouraged to maintain community links and are assisted to attend offsite meetings.
