Quorn Health Service & Flinders House, provides Permanent Care, Respite Care and Ageing in Place

Flinders House, was completed in 1996. It is co-located to the Quorn Health Services. There are 21 low care beds available including respite.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer Recovery pathways to maintenance of independence and achieving personal goals, Allied health (high care only), Social worker, Diversional therapist, Medicare, On-site access to GP, pharmacy, Incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service) – (high care only), Entertainment, Electrical appliance testing, Postal service, Gardening assistance and arrangements for room telephone connections.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily, complimented by a rotating menu.

Location/Access

Quorn Health Service & Flinders House, is situated in the Flinders Ranges area of South Australia in the small rural township of Quorn. Flinders House is located adjacent to the Quorn Health Service.

Leisure & Well-Being

Quorn Health Service & Flinders House, caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Lifestyle Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.
