

Communal Areas

Southern Flinders Health Service, Crystal Brook has a lounge/dining area, activity room, visitors lounge, verandah areas and gardens.

Services

Southern Flinders Health Service, Crystal Brook provides Permanent Care, Respite Care and Ageing in Place.

Southern Flinders Health Service, Crystal Brook Hospital was founded in 1925 by community subscription. The facility has 12 high care places as well as providing acute and community-based health care services. The health service has an Emergency Department and provides maternity and surgical services. Crystal Brook Hospital is accredited through the Australian Council on Healthcare Standards.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer Healthy Ageing programs, Allied health (high care only), Social worker, Diversional therapist, Chaplain, Oral Hygiene check-ups, Medicare, Onsite access to GP, Incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service) – (high care only), Entertainment, Mobile Library, Electrical appliance testing, postal service, transport, Gardening assistance.

In addition to our comprehensive clinical care programs, we offer Recovery Pathways to maintenance of independence and achieving personal goals, Allied Health (high care only), Medicare, On-site access to GP, pharmacy, incontinence products & toiletries (subject to legislated scheduled service) – (high care only), entertainment, electrical appliance testing, postal service, gardening assistance, arrangements for room telephone connections.

Meals are prepared and cooked onsite daily, complimented by a rotating menu.

Location/Access

The Hospital is situated in a residential area of Crystal Brook, which is a quiet country township located in the Southern Flinders Ranges which is mainly an agricultural region. Southern Flinders Health, Crystal Brook, is a single level Residential Aged Care Facility, offering a home-like atmosphere for singles and couples and features landscaped gardens and surrounds.

Leisure & Well-Being

Southern Flinders Health Service, Crystal Brook caters for residents from diverse cultural backgrounds and our Leisure & Well-Being Program is designed to celebrate this diversity. Our adaptive and flexible program is also tailored to the needs of residents with dementia and other health issues.

The health service is strongly grounded in the local community. Our staff, residents and volunteers participate in a range of community events such as the local Christmas Pageant/Street Party and Christmas Carol evenings. In addition to the regular community events, we also offer scheduled, group and individual activities e.g., exercises, Tai Chi, craft, and one on one pampering. Residents can participate in individual and small group activities which target physical, intellectual, emotional, and social needs e.g., painting, cooking, activity stations. Cultural, religious, and traditional events are also celebrated with in the facility. Special community events can be attended. Various community groups visit onsite regularly e.g., kindergarten groups, school groups. For those residents who are unable to participate outside of the facility, there are a wide range of community groups who visit the health service. Some examples are kindergarten groups, school groups, Apex Club, Carol Singers, and church groups.
